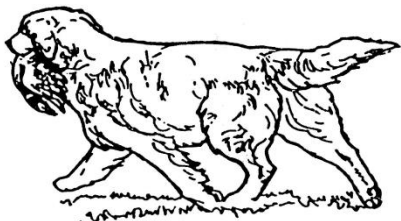

Neither Marshbanks Golden Retriever Club of South Central Michigan nor the property owners will be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog on the show grounds, whether as a result of an accident or any other cause. It is clearly understood that every dog entered in the show is in the care, custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Parents are responsible for their children.

NOTE TO EXHIBITORS

We cannot accept entries by telephone, that are without fees, or that are unsigned. Entries must be on Official AKC Entry Form that includes the Agreement and Rules.

Make checks and money orders payable to Marshbanks Golden Retriever Club of South-Central Michigan (or MGRC). Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show-giving club will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Overpayments of less than \$10 will be considered a donation to the Club and will not be returned.

Obedience entry fees include a \$0.50 AKC Recording Fee for every dog entered in the Obedience trial, and a \$3.00 AKC Event Services Fee for each Obedience class entered. Rally entry fees include a \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee for each Rally class entered.

Mail all entries with fees to **Laura Voncina, 5016 Brooklyn Rd, Jackson, MI 49201**. Entries sent overnight or express mail or other similar services should be designated **"NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED"**.

Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical after closing date with judging program and directions to the trial site. Should the exhibitor not receive such acknowledgement within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary via email laurav126@gmail.com.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms, whoever may make such errors. We will not refund any entry fee due to such errors or due to cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Bitches in Season – We will refund all entry fees less \$10.00 to any exhibitor who has a bitch entered that comes in season after the entries close. To be eligible for a refund, a veterinarian's statement must be presented to the Trial Secretary in person no later than 30 minutes **before** the start of the trial, or by mail or email, provided it is received prior to the opening of the trial in which the bitch is entered.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

No practicing will be allowed in the rings at any time.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dogs in judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Multiple Entries – When there is a multiple entry of the same dog, only the highest score will be eligible for special awards.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRY FEES

Please Note: Obedience and Rally Trials are separate events.

First entry of a dog (each event, each day) including AKC Fees **\$27.00**
Entry for Rally Team Competition Novice (for whole team) **\$27.00**
Each additional entry of the SAME dog (same event*) including AKC Fees **\$18.00**

*"Same event" means either obedience OR rally. For example: Open B + Utility B = \$42, Advanced B + Excellent B = \$42, Beginner Novice A + Advanced A = \$54.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Descriptions of all obedience and rally classes, including optional titling classes, may be found in the American Kennel Club's "Obedience Regulations" and "Rally Regulations".

UDX CLASS

Dogs entered in the UDX class will be entered in both Open B and Utility B, requiring the combined fee of \$45. Once the limit has been reached in either Open B or the Utility B class, the UDX class will close and accept no additional entries.

RAE CLASS

Dogs entered in the RAE class will be entered in both Advanced B and Excellent B. The combined fee is \$45 and the RAE class will close as soon as either one of the individual classes closes.

JUMP HEIGHT ORDER

All classes will run in ascending jump height order.

TRANSFERS

Requests for transfers must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Transfers may be approved, provided the next class level and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

RALLY AND OBEDIENCE TRIAL AWARDS

Qualifying Scores are required for all awards in regular classes. If a specific trophy is unavailable, a trophy of equal value will be substituted. "Dog" means either sex. Trophies not claimed on the day of the trial become the property of the Marshbanks Golden Retriever Club. No trophies will be mailed.

Due to space limitations, not all prizes are listed here; however, a full list may be obtained by contacting the Trial Secretary.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this 6and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally Trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed". Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
